














# Fire Hose Shed – Assembly Instructions

## Div. 2 `Keystone`, MCR, NMRA

### N, HO, S, O Scales



 <p>Place three of the four corner posts into the base. Do not glue if you want to remove the base later.</p>	 <p>Attach the back wall.</p>	 <p>Attach one side wall and the lower floor support.</p>
	 <p>Insert the water supply insulating post. Leave it slightly below the top surface for installation of the hydrant.</p>	
 <p>Install the lower shelf.</p>	 <p>Install the hose with the nozzle.</p>	 <p>Install the upper shelf.</p>
 <p>Install the upper hose without the nozzle. Install the hydrant above the water supply insulating post.</p>		<p>Attach the last corner post then the remaining side. Install the ceiling then the roof. Laminate the doors. Place the door stop posts in the base. Attach the doors.</p> <p>Once everything is dry, remove the base if desired. Paint as desired.</p>
